



## **ORIGIN 100% Iveco tour begins**

On 4 June the 2007 Customer Service Tour titled "Origin 100% Iveco" kicks off. The tour kicks off on the roads of Spain and Portugal on 4 June, and will be supported by a major radio and press advertising campaign. In July the tour hits the UK, and the next stops are France in September and Germany in October.
